

WBIDC signs lease agreements with 7 companies, April 18, 2012

In the august presence of Shri Partha Chatterjee, Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge, Department of Commerce and Industries & IT, Government of West Bengal, WBIDC signed lease agreements with 7 companies on April 18, 2012 for allotment of 546.004 acre of land in various industrial parks developed by WBIDC for a proposed total investment of Rs. 5281.58 crore. Shri Basudeb Banerjee, Principal Secretary, Commerce & Industries Department & IT Department, Government of West Bengal and Smt. Nandini Chakravorty, Managing Director, WBIDC were also present at the occasion.

These lease agreements were signed for the land allotted in the multiproduct and sector-specific industrial parks developed by WBIDC to promote rapid industrialization in the state.

In Panagarh Industrial Park, lease agreement was signed with Matix Fertilisers and Chemicals Limited which has been allotted 494.844 acres of land for setting up of a Fertiliser and Chemical plant involving an investment of Rs. 5000 crore.

Lease agreement was signed with Mahabharat Motors Manufacturing Company Private Limited against allotment of 35.16 acre land at Uluberia Industrial Park for setting up Automobile Park with a proposed investment of Rs. 200 crore.

In Vidyasagar Industrial Park, developed mainly for industrial manufacturing units, lease agreements were signed with Accropoly Ninomiy India Pvt. Limited allotting them with 5 acres of land for setting up of a sheet metal and excavator parts unit with a proposed investment of Rs. 13.39 crore. Another lease deed was signed by WBIDC with Ganapati Flour & Foods Private Limited allotting them with 4 acres of land in the same park for setting up Wheat Products, flour mill accessories & spare part unit with a proposed investment of Rs. 5.36 crore.

Lease agreements were also signed with Wimplast Limited, Suguna Poultry Farm Limited and DTL Ancillaries Limited for having allotted them 2, 3 and 2 acres of land respectively in the multiproduct industrial park- Rishi Bankim Shilpaudyan at Naihati.
