Vast Road Network

State has vast network of 3,15,404 km with road density of 333.5 km per 1000 sq. meter with 17 National Highways and 2 Asian Highways



Excellent Air Connectivity

Two international airports at Kolkata and Bagdogra and private sector greenfield airport at Andal, West Bardhaman



Extensive Waterways

Navigable waterways with 950 km (~30% of country's navigable inland waterways) & 13% of national coastline. Oldest maritime infrastructure with two major ports at Kolkata and Haldia. Upcoming deep seaport at Tajpur shall strengthen the logistics infrastructure in the state.



Huge Railway Network

Rail density with ~4000 km of railway tracks and has 2nd largest metro rail network in the country



Numerous Industrial Parks

200+ industrial parks have been established across the state over 15,000 acres of land



Power Surplus State

State generates over 10,000 MW of power. Of this, 18% is generated from non-conventional sources such as hydel and solar



Warehousing & Storage Capacity

Largest warehousing capacity in eastern India with over 2.4 million tonnes capacity. The state is a national leader in cold storage capacity of 7.98 million tonnes



Significant no. of MSMEs

Bengal has one of the highest number of MSMEs and it is home to highest number of women entrepreneurs (23%) in the country
